Who is the course for?

The 2-day Family Engagement Training course is for anyone who works directly with parents and carers. This course is also suitable for senior leaders looking to develop family engagement and positive behaviour support for families at an organisational level.

Please note, you must have valid Level One Team Teach training certification (or beyond) to participate in this course.

This training takes the philosophy of Team Teach and identifies how core messages can be shared with families to better support children's behaviour, therefore an understanding of the Team Teach approach is essential.

This course will help you to...

- understand the challenges and opportunities when working with families, including barriers to communication, negative perceptions, and ways to increase parent/carer engagement
- understand of the Team Teach approach and how it can help families understand and support their child's behaviour
- identify next steps for improving accessibility to information and consider the effectiveness of current family engagement strategies for supporting children's behaviour
- successfully facilitate family workshops with parents and carers, using My Family Coach supporting resources, underpinned by the Team Teach philosophy and approach to behaviour.





Family Engagement Training 2-day course





The first day is focused on the context of your particular setting and on developing a toolkit of ideas and strategies you can use to improve communication with the families you work with.

We'll discuss building trusting relationships, the barriers and challenges you face, and ways you can change perceptions.

We'll also explore ways to diffuse conflict and create spaces for emotional conversations and how to work with parents and carers so they feel part of the decision making for their child.

The second day is an opportunity to learn more about delivering My Family Coach behaviour training workshops to support the families you work with in your setting.

You'll focus on accessibility and how you can reach even more families, feeding into your Accessibility Plan.

The My Family Coach workshops you'll be able to deliver will help families better understand their child's behaviour and develop skills in positive behaviour support (verbal and nonverbal communication), positive listening and learning, diversion and de-escalation.

You'll also look at ways to personalise the workshops to the needs of families in your setting and work collaboratively with other course participants to deliver some practice workshop modules effectively in group presentations.
